Approval of Agenda: Moved, Mike Chambers; seconded, Mike Hancher. Unanimous.

Treasurer's Report: Bank balance \$7893.50. Mike is working on computerizing records back to 2011. Question as to whether MEDTSEA should file a 990.

Directors agreed that conference focus would be on health issues (mental, physical, etc.) of driver education profession. 2) LD 877—permit issuance privileges returned to driver education schools.

New Business: Ben Mullen suggested that MEDTSEA advocate for a new driver education instructor classification that would allow senior instructors no longer comfortable with in-car instruction to continue as classroom teachers.
