Eric Belevance: TRP: Class A school may be authorized to provide electronic instruction, electronic media must be approved by SOS and provided in conjunction with approved curriculum. Expiration of Driver Ed License, 1 year to 2 years. SOS may extend up to 60 days given extenuating circumstances. Class A or B instructor must be 25 and held a license for at least 4 years. Standard First aid course, any approved. Instructor with med/mental issue from function ability profile.

MEDTSEA suggests federal back ground check at initial application. Instructor trainings good as 1 year approved course. Regular Class B must have completed introductory last 4 years. Class B mentored by class A or B with 6 years experience. 16 hours of continuing education every 2 years. Strike first aid renewal. Class A 60 hours classroom and 20 hours behind the wheel. Class B 40 hours behind the wheel. Administrator can still qualify with extenuating circumstances. Provisional instructor license – work under limited supervision, renewed by designated person. Class A instructor minimum number of years. New text/curriculum – student (mandate) purchase book. ADTSEA curriculum?
